MOTION TO REVOKE OR INCREASE BOND

Comes now, BRUCE BARTLETT, State Attorney for the Sixth Judicial Circuit of Florida, and moves this Honorable Court to revoke or increase bond in the above-styled cause, and as grounds therefore would state:

1. On July 29, 2025, the Defendant was arrested for Battery.
2. On July 30, 2025, the Defendant posted a one-thousand-dollar bond.
3. On September 20, 2025, the Defendant committed another Battery against a different victim in Pinellas County.
4. On October 23, 2025, the State filed an Information for the new battery charge in case 25-15304-MM.
5. Pursuant to Fla. Stat. 903.047(1)(a): "as a condition of pretrial release, whether such release is by surety bond or recognizance bond or in some other form the defendant must refrain from criminal activity of any kind."

6. Therefore, the Defendant violated conditions of his pretrial release by committing a new law violation on September 20, 2025.

WHEREFORE, the State of Florida moves this Court to enter an Order granting the State's Motion to Revoke Defendant's Bond, or in the alternative, should the Defendant not be present in the courtroom, to increase Defendant's bond to zero and issue a capias, in the above-captioned case and hold the Defendant without bond.
